

### **Rhätikon-Ferwall- and Silvretta group (before 1909)**

The map of Rhätikon-Ferwall- and Silvretta group was published before 1909 by the Institute of Cartography by Paasche and Luz (Stuttgart and Berlin). This map belongs to the series "Walter Paasche's Wanderkarte". The map was edited after the special map of German and Austrian Alp society 1:50'000, the Austrian special map 1:75'000 and the map sheets of Swiss Siegfried Atlas 1:50'000. There is no date on the map. However, "before 1909" was written with a pen on the map. The scale is 1:100'000. The map covers a part of Switzerland and of Austria.
