

Special maps of Eastern Alps: Timbler Joch (1876)

The map of Timbler Joch was published in 1876 by the journal of the German and Austrian Alp society and belongs to a collection of special maps of Eastern Alps. The collection is not complete. The map covers a part of Austria and of Italy. The scale is 1:50'000. The map was edited after the new picture of the k.u.k. Institute of Military and Geography by Prof. Dr. K. Haushofer and C. Hoffmann (Lithograph.).
