

Special maps of Eastern Alps: Venice group (18) (1883)

The map of Venice group (18) was published in 1883 by the journal of the German and Austrian Alp society and belongs to a collection of special maps of Eastern Alps. The collection is not complete. The map covers a part of Austria. The scale is 1:50'000. The engraving and the printing were done by the Institute of Cartography (H. Petters, Hildburghausen). I. Purtscheller did the nomenclature.
