

Special maps of Eastern Alps: Berchtesgaden (Sheet II) (1885-1887)

The map of Berchtesgaden (Sheet II) was published in 1885-87 by the journal of the German and Austrian Alp society and belongs to a collection of special maps of Eastern Alps. The map covers a part of Austria and of Germany. The scale is 1:50'000. The south-north coordinates are 47°35' – 47°45'. The west-east coordinates are 30°37' – 30°50'. The drawing of the Austrian part and the engraving and the printing were done by the Institute of Cartography (H. Petters, Hildburghausen). A. Waltenberger drew the Bavarian part.
